


## **Current status about IRIS**

- Booklet available in 7 languages.






## **Comparison IRIS – ISO**

## Part 3: Rev. 02 → Stability

- IRIS decided to freeze the Rev. 02 for the next 3 years:
  - ► Applicable solely from January 1st, 2010 on,
  - Mature requirements,
  - Ensure a stable basis for auditors,
  - ▶ Give the opportunity to the companies to get through a full Certification Process in the revision and to allow them to use the full potential of improvements.

► Mandatory/recommended requirements give the freedom to each company to define the expected level (with the help of the Audit-tool).
